

NATIONAL JUNIOR HONOR SOCIETY REQUIREMENTS

2018-2019 School Year

*To be considered for membership in the Caddo Middle Magnet Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society, a student must be a seventh grader and must meet the requirements listed below.

* Meeting these requirements does not guarantee a student membership but will place a student's name into consideration for the Honor Society Committee's evaluation.

1. Students must be in the seventh or eighth grade.
2. Students must maintain a minimum of 3.75 cumulative grade point average for the first semester.
3. Students must participate in at least 2 community service activity within the current school year. Students need signatures from supervisor of the community service. Parent signatures will not be accepted. This must be a hands-on volunteer experience that was not for the benefit of your own group. (ex.: church youth choir doesn't count; singing with your church youth choir at a nursing home does count.) Other examples: serving meals at a shelter, working with an animal shelter, putting on a party for needy children, visiting residents at a nursing home, etc. Simply donating money or items does not count as hands-on service.
4. The Honor Society Committee will verify first semester grades. Students who meet the academic requirements, and have turned in an application will be evaluated during a faculty meeting by their first semester teachers as to their good character, positive leadership, and good citizenship. Students must meet a minimum average score of 2.7 out of 3 from the faculty recommendations to be considered by the Honor Society Committee. Student's responsibility, attitude, behavior, and positive leadership in the classroom will be evaluated
5. Students are expected to have an acceptable discipline record for their entire time at CMM. Any referral, from any year, will be seriously scrutinized and very likely will disqualify a student from membership. If the student has any breach of the Caddo Middle Magnet Honor Code, two After School Detentions or one In-School-Suspension then he/she will be ineligible for membership.

Applications will be made available on the CMM website after 1 December. Students who are eligible are responsible to print, fill out, and turn in the application. Applications must be turned in, in person, to the sponsor. Deadline on the application is firm and final. Applications placed in sponsor's box or on sponsor's desk will not be considered.

Following the grade, recommendation, and disciple evaluations, invitations for membership will be offered. Students must return the signed membership responsibility form and dues to the sponsor, in person, by the deadline in order to be inducted into membership. Forms placed in the sponsor's box or on sponsor's desk will not be accepted. Deadline on the form is firm and final
